Dear Andrew, Further to my email below regarding the mapping for 110 and 112 Whalley Road, Accrington, Lancashire, BB5 1BS. My technical team have completed their investigation and have advised me of the following: We are not able to comment on when or whether someone updated their mapping (from ours) 17 or 18 years ago. Number 110 has been updated since this time with an extension added in July 2018 and the minor detail within its garden has been deleted. Currently, HM Land Registry receive daily change only updates from Ordnance Survey. Licenced resellers and Public Sector Mapping Agreement customers receive OS MasterMap updates every 6 weeks. So any updates made to our basic scale mapping is received by these customers at these intervals. I hope that this information has been helpful to you.
