Based upon my examination of the Word document and the email to which it is attached, both of which are present inside the archive.pst post office file, I am satisfied that the material is present in its original form and that it has not undergone any editing, modification or alteration since arriving in Mr Hall's Outlook inbox.
41. Whilst it is impossible to determine if the dates and times recorded are accurate, they are at least consistent with each other and I have found no artefacts or other evidence which leads me to doubt their veracity.



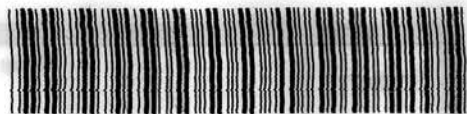

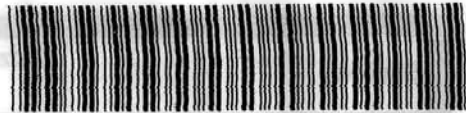

ASSIGNMENTS

Assignment is the sale of a patent/application. An assignment document may be quite straight forward, but as the transfer of ownership is involved it may be preferred to employ the services of a Solicitor or Patent Agent. However, if drawing up the document oneself, the following should be borne in mind.

Assignments must state:

The present owner of the patent/application giving both name and address(seller).

That the buyer is acquiring ownership and give his full name and address.

The signatures of all parties involved.

The number(s) of the patent/application.

Confirm that sale took place.

The date of the transaction.

Stamp Duty is not necessary if the assignment is completed on or after 28 March 2000.

In order to register the assignment:-

File Patent Form 21/77 the fee is currently nil (£0). Provided the form 21/77 has been signed by the assignor, no additional documents need to be sent. However, if the signature cannot be obtained, the original document &/or a copy of the document should be sent with the form 21/77.

When registration has been made, the original will be returned endorsed with the Comptroller's stamp, if a copy was provided for retention on file, where it will be open to public inspection.
