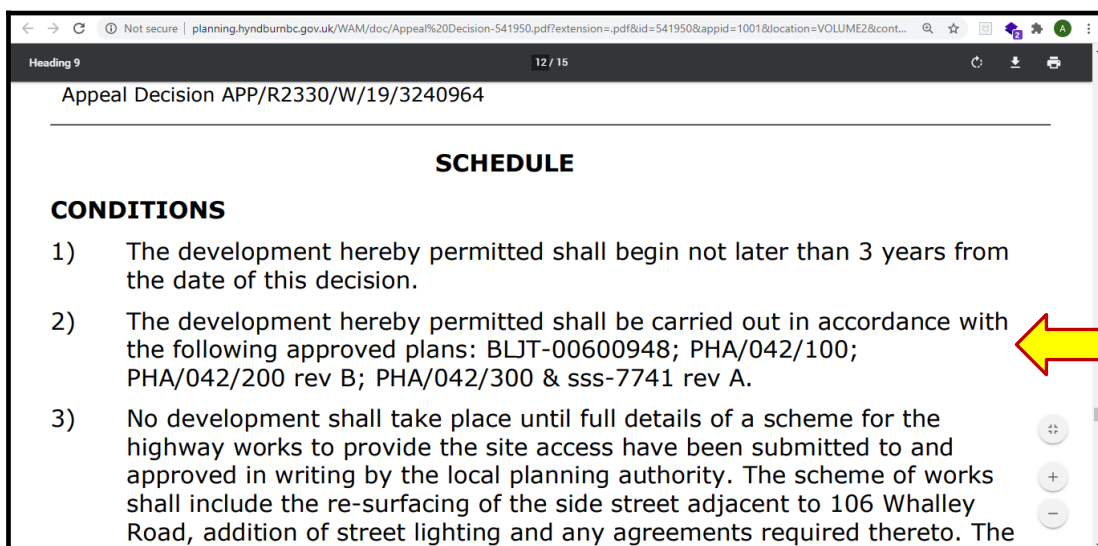


OBSERVATION RE: “the following approved plans” IPFI/112/CASE3

On 20 February 2017, the Architect/Agent (PHA) of a plant hire company (J&R) purchased an extract of the Ordnance Survey MasterMap from Bluejet Mapping Ltd under a one-year licence, ID: **BLJT00600948**.

- This OS Extract ID has turned up in a 26 February 2020 [Decision on Appeal](#) issued by a Secretary of State-appointed Planning Inspectorate Inspector:

Appreciably, the LPA disregarded the “TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY” when listing plans for determination of (i) [11/19/0211](#) ([recommend for grant](#), [pp.11-13] but [refused](#)) and (ii) the previous application [11/18/0177](#) ([recommended for grant](#) *, but [refused](#)).

* refers to a refused 2005 planning application (not present in the 2005 planning application search results).
